

FORMAT



SUMMARY

- All teams will be allocated in 3 equal pools.
- The pool draw will be completed the evening prior to commencement of play.
- The format of the TPL Next Gen is Baker format.
- Order of Play will involve:
 - Bowler 1 will play frames 1,4,7, and 10
 - Bowler 2 will play frames 2,5, and 8.
 - Bowler 3 will play frames 3,6, and 9.
- The lead-off bowler (bowler 1 in above example) in each team must change each game.
- each baker game will be played on a single lane (no cross-over).

ROUND 1 - APRIL 12

- Each team will complete 9 baker games
- The top 5 from each pool by total pinfall will progress to Round 2
- Any team missing the cut, will be placed in a 1 game desperado squad. This Desperado squad will occur at the conclusion of pool 3. The highest team game by pinfall from the Desperado squad will progress through to round 2.
- A total of 16 teams will progress to Round 2.

ROUND 2 - APRIL 13

- The 16 teams will be divided into 2 pools of 8 teams.
- Pinfall drops at start of round 2.
- Pool composition will be determined by odds and evens of finishing places from Round 1. Example: - Pool 1 (odds) – Teams placed 1, 3, 5,7 ,9 ,11 ,13 and 15 from Round 1 - Pool 2 (even) – Teams placed 2,4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, and 16 (Desperado winner) from Round 1.
- Each team will play 7 baker games of Matchplay against each other team in their pool
- Points will be awarded as follows: - 3 points for a win - 1 point for a tie - 0 points for a loss
- Top 2 seeds from each pool will progress to the semi-finals.
- Ties for 1st and 2nd seed will be determined by a 1 game roll off. If still tied, a 8th, 9th, and 10th frame shootout will be activated. If still tied after this, a sudden death single ball elimination will be activated until the tie is broken.
- Ties on points for all other placings will be determined by total pinfall from Round 2. If still tied, then pinfall from round 1 is included. If tie remains, highest last game determines final placing and continues to highest 2nd last game etc. until tie is broken.


FORMAT

SEMI-FINAL - APRIL 13

- Top Seed from Odd Pool V 2nd Seed from Even Pool.
- 2nd Seed from Odd Pool V 2nd Seed from Even Pool.
- 1 Game – Baker Format
- Winners progress to Grand Final.
- Same Tie Breaker rules applied as per previous rounds

GRAND FINAL - APRIL 13

- Semi-Final winners will meet in the Grand Final for a 1 game final in Baker format.
- Note, lead-off bowler needs to change from the semi-final match.
- Same Tie Breaker rules applied as per previous rounds.
- Winner crowned inaugural TPL Next Gen Champions.



RULES & REGULATIONS

- This is a scratch event that is open to all 2024 TBA Junior Members.
- All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA rules and regulations.
- TBA registration checks will be checked prior to the commencement of the event
- Team entry fee - \$540
- Refund of Entry Fees – Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:
 - 1) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries on TenpinResults
 - 2) Request a Cash-Out of the total credit amount less the processing fee (3%)
- Dress code – appropriate bowling attire to be worn – dress shorts for men will be permitted. Jeans, tights, or track pants are not acceptable.
- The Tournament Director and TBA reserve the right to check any bowler's equipment at any time. Any equipment to be found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.
- Any team that fails to check in on for round 2, semi-final, or grand final, will be replaced by the first available reserve.
- Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.
- Smoking, Consumption of alcohol and use of mobile phones while competing are not permitted.
- Ties for 1st and 2nd seed will be determined by a 1 game roll off. If still tied, a 8th, 9th, and 10th frame shootout will be activated. If still tied after this, a sudden death single ball elimination will be activated until the tie is broken.
- Ties on points for all other placings will be determined by total pinfall from Round 2. If still tied, then pinfall from round 1 is included. If tie remains, highest last game determines final placing and continues to highest 2nd last game etc. until tie is broken.
