## Tournament Format

STAGE 1 All bowlers bowl 10 games qualifying, in $2 \times 5$ game appearances. Pinfall dropped
STAGE 2 Top 28 bowlers bowl a further 5 games ( $5 \times 1$ game blocks) pinfall dropped
STAGE 3 Top 14 bowlers bowl a further $\mathbf{3}$ games ( $3 \times 1$ game blocks) pinfall dropped
STAGE 4 Top 8 bowlers bowl 7 games round robin match play ( $1 \times$ full round plus position round)
FINALS Top 3 stepladder, no repêchage for top seed

## Tournament Conditions

- This is to be a scratch event which is open to all 2022 TBA Registered Players. All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA Rules \& Regulations. 2022 TBA registered player cards must be presented at check-in.
- Refund of Entry Fees - Should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options
- Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries
- Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee (3\%)
- Dress codes -Dress trousers and appropriate bowling shirt for men and skirt, skort, dress shorts or trousers and appropriate bowling shirt for women.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to check any bowler's equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim to any prize money.
- Any bowler not checked-in in for Stages 2,3 or the final will be replaced by the first available reserve.
- Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Directors whose decision will be final.
- Smoking, consumption of alcohol \& use of mobile phones while competing is not permitted.
- This centre is TBA registered, and has a government approved Covid plan or guidelines in place.
- This accredited event will be held in accordance with any current guidelines as set out by state/territory government, ensuring centre capacity and social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- TIES- A tie for 28th place after Stage 1 (qualifying) will be decided by the highest last game in Stage 1. A tie for 14 th place after Stage 2 will be decided by the highest last game in Stage 2. A tie for 8th place after Stage 3 will be decided by a one game playoff at the completion of Stage 3. A tie for 3rd place after Matchplay will be decided by a one game playoff at the completion of Matchplay. If a tie still exists, a 10th frame playoff will occur until the tie is broken. If a tie exists for 1st place at the conclusion of the Finals, $a$ one game playoff will take place. If a tie still exists, a 10th frame playoff will occur until the tie is broken.
