MASTERS ELIGIBILITY: All bowlers must have completed an All Events score to qualify for a 2026 Masters Final. One Masters qualifying is automatic with your 9 game Championship entry. Bowlers with averages (boys 145 girls 135 and below) will automatically be entered into the Restricted Masters, all bowlers above these averages will be entered into the Open Masters.

JUNIOR STATE RESTRICTED MASTERS



FINAL - Saturday 6th June 2026

COSTS - \$150

CHECK IN BY - 12.30pm

This is a handicap Tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) open to all junior bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause. Handicap will be 100% of 300.

Qualifying score for Restricted Masters will be the bowler's 9 games series plus handicap. A tie for 12th position will be decided by the highest last game, plus handicap, bowled in their qualifying.

Check in closes at 12.30 pm **Saturday 6th June 2026**, any bowler/s not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserve/s.

In each division, the finals will be the top 12 qualifiers who will bowl 8 games in 4 X 2 game blocks. A tie for first, second or third places, will be decided on highest last game plus handicap bowled.

The defending champion (if eligible) and the local area champions will get an automatic(unpaid) spot in the finals.

CHAMPION WILL RECEIVE: First place trophy, shirt, 50% of prize fund, plus an unpaid entry into the 2027 Junior State Restricted Masters (if eligible). **Second place:** trophy and 25% of prize fund. **Third place:** trophy and 15%of prize fund. **Fourth place:** 10% of prize fund.

JUNIOR STATE OPEN MASTERS



FINAL - Sunday 7th June 2026

COSTS - \$200

CHECK IN BY - 7.00am

This is a scratch tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and open to all junior bowlers who comply with the clause.

Qualifying score for Open Masters will be the bowlers All Events pin fall. A tie for 12th position will be decided by the highest last scratch game in their qualifying series.

FINAL: The top 12 qualifiers in each division will bowl 11 games head-to-head. Points will be allocated for each head-to-head game based on the following: 20 points for a win, 10 points for a draw and 0 points for a loss. In the event of vacancies, a bowler playing

against a vacancy will receive an automatic win for that game.

The winner in each division will be the bowler with the highest pin fall plus bonus points.

Check in closes at **7:00 am on Sunday 7th June 2026**, Any bowler/s not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserve/s.

The defending champion (if eligible) and the local area champions will get an automatic (unpaid) spot in the finals.

CHAMPION WILL RECEIVE: First place trophy, shirt, 50% of prize fund, plus an unpaid entry into the 2027 Junior State Restricted Masters (if eligible). **Second place:** trophy and 25% of prize fund. **Third place:** trophy and 15%of prize fund. **Fourth place:** 10% of prize fund.



GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS



This tournament will be accredited with TBA and all rules and regulations of TBA will apply.

ELIGIBILITY: This tournament is open to all juniors who are current TBAL registered bowlers, who are bowling in a TBAL scheduled league in a TBAL registered Centre, who are currently residing in Queensland, who have done so for a period of 3 months immediately prior to closing date of championships. The North Queensland Executive reserve the right to invite bowlers from outside North Queensland to participate in these events.

BOWLER CODE OF ETHICS: Competitors must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect negatively on TBAL, TBAQ, NQJC or their City Association/Sub Committee or the sport of Tenpin Bowling. The Tournament Director has the right to penalise bowlers for violations of the TBAL Code of Ethics. The yellow/red card system will be in force throughout this event.

DATE OF CHAMPIONSHIPS: The Championships will be held at MLC, Mackay - **Friday 5th and Saturday 6th June 2026**

FORMAT: All bowlers must bowl a singles, doubles and teams' event and pay for an all events entry. These 9 games will be your qualifying scores for the masters.

AVERAGES TO USE: The average to be used for these Championships will be the bowlers highest League average over a minimum of 24 games in a TBA registered league as of **31st March 2026**

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE: A bowler without a Yearbook average must apply to the Tournament Director for an average to be assigned. All relevant information required by the Tournament Director, to assign an average, must be supplied by the bowler. Application must be made prior to closing date of entries.

REPLACEMENTS: Any change to the original submitted entry form must be reported to the Tournament Coordinator no later than 30 minutes prior to the relevant squad time. Every attempt must be made to find a replacement bowler within the same average range.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: As there are limited squads available, multiple participation will not be possible. Except where it is found necessary to fill a team in another squad or to fill a squad.

ALL EVENTS: All event scores will be each of the bowlers 9 game series for Teams, Doubles and Singles

MASTERS ELIGIBILITY: Qualifying for Masters will be their **HIGHEST** 9 game event series.

DRESS CODE FOR MASTERS EVENTS: All bowlers in these Tournaments will be required to wear a suitable length collared and sleeved shirt or a recognised bowling shirt, socks/stockings, and (A) skirt/skorts/long dress shorts for females (B) dress shorts/trousers for males. No denim, board shorts will be permitted. (Leggings will be permitted at the discretion of the Tournament Director)

PRIZE FUND: Payouts of Prize funds will be 1 prize for each 4 entries.

SMOKING: The Junior State Championships and master's events are **NON-SMOKING** events

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES: Entries will be taken on the Tenpin Results Website only.

Entries will Close **Tuesday 4th June 2026 at 6.00pm**. Late entries will only be accepted on Squad availability.

REFUND RULES: Refund of Entry Fees- should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player has two options,

1. Use the total credit for any tournament that is using online entries.
2. Request a Cash-out of the total credit less the processing fee (3%)

ALL OTHER MATTERS: All other matters which may arise and are not covered in these Tournament Rules will be decided by the Tournament Directors after consultation with the NQJC Executive
